



Kathy Schrock has been a school district Director of Technology, an instructional technology specialist, an adjunct education professor, and a middle school, academic, museum, and public library librarian. She is currently teaching online graduate courses for Wilkes University as part of the Wilkes-Discovery Masters program. She is an Adobe Education Leader, a Google Certified Teacher, and a Discovery Education STAR and GURU. In addition to teaching online, Kathy writes, speaks, blogs, tweets, and conducts professional development workshops, presentations, and keynotes throughout the world. She is known for her practical presentations dealing with pedagogically sound practices for the embedding of technology seamlessly into teaching and learning.

She is well-known in the education field as the creator of *Kathy Schrock's Guide for Educators*. This extensive Web site was started in June of 1995 to help fellow educators identify curriculum-related Web resources to enhance their units of study. Kathy partnered with Discovery Education to host the site from 1999-2012. She now writes an informative blog for Discovery Education entitled *Kathy's Katch* and maintains a new site for educators, Kathy Schrock's Guide to Everything.

She is the author of numerous articles in such print publications as *Technology and Learning*, *Learning and Leading with Technology*, *Instructor*, and *School Library Journal* and online sites such as *Discovery Education* and *TeachHub*. She is also the author of a number of educational technology books.

Extremely interested in information literacy, search strategies, copyright issues, infographics, the role of emerging technologies to support teaching and learning, and critical Web site evaluation, Kathy received her BS in elementary/special education from Rutgers College in 1979 and her MLS in Library Studies from Rutgers School of Communication and Information in 1981. She has been a speaker, both nationally and internationally, at over 250 technology, education, and library conferences.

Kathy has also received numerous technology-related accolades including the *Making IT Happen* award from both ISTE and Massachusetts CUE, named as a Top Five Innovator in Education (along with Papert, Gates, Wozniak, and Jobs) by *Technology and Learning* magazine, and honored as the Rutgers School of Communication and Information *Alumna of the Year*.
