



Kathy Schrock has been a school district Director of Technology, an instructional technology specialist, an adjunct education professor, and a middle school, academic, museum, and public library librarian. She is currently teaching online graduate courses for Wilkes University, as part of the Wilkes-Discovery masters program and also at Arcadia University. She is an Adobe Education Leader, a Google Certified Teacher, a Discovery Education STAR and GURU. In addition to teaching online, Kathy writes, speaks, blogs, tweets, and conducts professional development workshops, presentations, and keynotes throughout the world. She is known for her practical presentations dealing with pedagogically sound practices for the embedding of technology seamlessly into teaching and learning.

Extremely interested in information literacy, search strategies, copyright issues, infographics, the role of emerging technologies to support teaching and learning, and critical Web site evaluation, Kathy received her BS in elementary/special education from Rutgers College in 1979 and her MLS from Rutgers Graduate School of Library and Information Studies in 1981. She has been a speaker, both nationally and internationally, at dozens of technology and library conferences.

Kathy has also received numerous technology-related accolades including the *Making IT Happen* award from both ISTE and Massachusetts CUE, named as a Top Five Innovator in Education (along with Papert, Gates, Wozniak, and Jobs) by *Technology and Learning* magazine, and honored as the Rutgers University School of Communication, Information, and Library Studies *Alumna of the Year*.
